When looking at their Writing books, I was amazed at the progress they have already made. The children showed me the actions and sounds that match the letters they had been writing and I could see how they have improved their mark making skills and forming recognizable letters. I was particularly impressed with their blending skills when sharing their colour-banded reading books. Blending can be tricky when you are first learning to recognize sounds, but all of the children showed our value of determination and kept trying.
