Attendance

There have been a few enquiries about the attendance letters that were sent home recently. To clarify, when children are absent from school due to Covid this is marked as I for illness whether or not children are displaying symptoms and actually unwell. At the beginning of the pandemic, the attendance coding was different and isolation for asymptomatic children did not affect attendance percentages. It does now.

However, at the end of this term when you receive your child's updated attendance, this will be recorded differently on the letter from school. It will still be possible for children to achieve a 100% certificate from school if their only absence has been caused by an enforced Covid self-isolation.

Cold Weather Clothing

As the temperature has suddenly dropped this week, please make sure children bring a coat to school and wear a fleece, jumper or cardigan. We need to keep windows and doors ajar to maintain good ventilation. The heating is working well thanks to our new boilers but some areas of school may seem draughty.

Black Hoodies

It has been brought to our attention that some parents and carers have been under the impression that a black hoodie is part of our school PE uniform. It is not and never has been. During the pandemic when shops were closed, our uniform rules were relaxed and various sportswear was permitted. However, this changed when school fully reopened and children have been expected to wear full school uniform since April.

When it is cold and children are taking part in outdoor PE, they may bring a warm jumper or hoodie for the lesson, but should wear their school jumper, cardigan or fleece for the rest of the day.



For Year 4 children taking part in Bootcamp, old, warm, waterproof clothes are acceptable and highly recommended because children can get very muddy.

Covid Cases

We have had confirmed cases this week in years 2, 3 & 6. Unfortunately, we also have 3 teachers isolating. Parents & carers of children in these classes have already been notified.

To reduce the transmission of the virus and enable school to remain open, it is vital that everyone takes part in twice-weekly Lateral Flow Testing (LFT). This helps to identify asymptomatic individuals as well as distinguishing between

Covid and normal childhood illnesses.

School continues to observe good respiratory hygiene (Catch-it, Bin-it, Kill-it approach) to further help eliminate the transmission.
