COVID Update

As you will be aware, most of the Covid restrictions have been lifted. Regular LFD tests and isolation are no longer compulsory. However, if children have any of the recognised COVID symptoms, it is recommended they stay at home for 3 days. If they are well enough, it is expected they will continue their learning from home via Google Classroom.

Good ventilation, respiratory and hand hygiene remain essential. Hand sanitizer is still readily available around school and children are using this before eating and after sneezing.

Recognised Covid symptoms in children include:

- a high temperature or shivering (chills) a high temperature means feeling hot to touch on their chest or back
- a new, continuous cough this means coughing a lot for more than an hour, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours
- a loss or change to your sense of smell or taste
- shortness of breath
- feeling tired or exhausted
- an aching body
- a headache
- a sore throat
- a blocked or runny nose
- loss of appetite
- diarrhoea
- · feeling sick or being sick
