As you will be aware, our aim is for children to become independent, motivated learners and responsible citizens. An integral part of this is developing children's social skills so that they can maintain existing relationships, but also have the self-confidence and empathy to work well with new people and to build new friendships more easily in the future.

For this reason, when children move from Reception into year 1, from year 2 into year 3, and from year 4 into year 5, the combination of children in each class is mixed. In addition, we consider the impact that the existing combination of pupils from other year groups is having on their learning.
