Ollie Swindells 2LQ & Henley Goodey 2AB - competed in a football tournament last weekend and his Team Wickford Pumas were the group winners

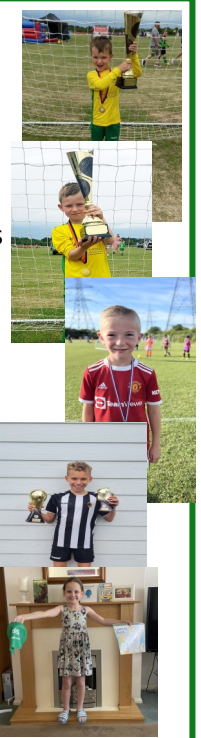
Harper Saunders 2AB - Bronze medal for her fantastic efforts during the Year 2 Mini-Commonwealth Games
