Remote Education

Further to my previous letter, I am now writing to confirm arrangements for the next two weeks.

As outlined in our [Contingency Plan](#), teachers & learning support assistants (LSAs) will deliver daily lessons via Zoom then set activities on the [Remote Education](#) page of your school website for children to complete during the day. Please email children's work to the year group email, either directly or by taking a photo and sending the image. This will enable teachers & LSAs to provide appropriate feedback to children and amend lessons accordingly.

Teachers within each year group will stagger their lessons, so if you have more than one child sharing a device, they can log on to another teacher's lesson from their year group. Zoom links for each teacher will be emailed later today and the same link will be used for every lesson. Please remember, for safeguarding reasons, not to share this link with anyone outside our school community and make sure that anyone in view of the camera is appropriately dressed.

It is expected that children will engage with this daily learning, so class teachers will contact parents & carers if they have not seen or heard from your child.

Key Worker and Vulnerable Pupils

Children attending school during this time, will engage with the Zoom lessons within their classroom and complete the activities with their teacher or LSA afterwards. These children will remain in either their own class bubble or year-group bubble according to pupil numbers. Uniform should be worn and old shoes / wellies or slippers should be brought into school as an extra set of footwear. If your child is having PE, you will be informed via text, then they should come to school dressed in PE kit / sportswear.

Dinners

Hot school meals will be available. All lower school children will receive a universal free school meal as well as those in receipt of free school meals at upper school. School dinners can be purchased for other children attending upper school in the usual way, via Schoolmoney.

Arrival & Departure Times

Children should enter school via their usual entrance but year 6 can walk through the year 3 gate rather than the car park, to reach the back playground. School day times are:

Lower School

Upper School
8.40am – 3.05pm
