


Reading, Writing and Maths		
Maths	<p>To recognise and name coins. To find the total amount by adding two coins together. Talk about situations you may need to use money to buy things. Discuss that we keep money in the bank.</p> <p>Set up a shop in your home. Label some items with price tags from tapestry, showing amounts up to 10p/20p. Role play buying small items from the shop, making the right amount of money using 1p coins.</p>  <p>Challenge: Use a variety of coins up to 20p to make the amounts, e.g. 5p and 2p to make 7p.</p>	<p>Suggested time: 25 minute live lesson 20 minute activity</p>
Phonics	<p>Watch Geraldine! https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EneZ1UubxSA Practise writing ear, beard, dear, fear, hear, tear. Draw a picture to match the words if you can!</p>	<p>Suggested time: 25 minute live lesson 20 minute activity</p>
Reading	<p>Read a book on Bug Club. Can you use your phonemes to sound out the words? Can you answer the comprehension questions? Challenge: can you write your answer in a sentence and read it back?</p>	<p>Suggested time: 15 minutes</p>
Writing	<p>To use some clearly identifiable letters to communicate meaning, representing some sounds correctly and in sequence. To segment the sounds in words. Design your own wild thing and label it using describing words (adjectives) . Can you write some of your describing words into sentences?</p>  <p>Challenge: Create some funny names for the 'wild thing' creatures.</p>	<p>Suggested time: 20 minutes</p>
Expressive art and design	<p>Use a toilet/kitchen roll to create a wild thing.</p> 	<p>Suggested time: 20 minutes</p>
Physical development	<p>Fine motor skills – Where the wild things colouring sheets. Gross motor skills – Joe Wicks- Daily PE session on YouTube.</p>	<p>Suggested time: 20 minutes</p>
Understanding the world	<p>Collect leaves from your garden/ a local park. Could you make a collage of all the different shape and coloured leaves</p> 	<p>Suggested time: 15 minutes</p>
Extra activities	<p>Name practise (first and surname) Counting out loud and counting out objects of varying amounts. Practise getting dressed independently and fastenings such as zips and gloves. Letter and number formation practise. Help with jobs around the house, for example, matching/pairing the socks. Practise counting in 2s. Can you say the number one more/one less than any number to 20?</p>	<p>Suggested time: 30 minutes</p>
