On Bug Club, read the book, '101 Things to do Before You Leave for Secondary School'. Choose a selection of memorable activities to complete.



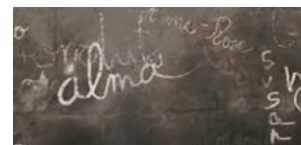
We would like you to choose a shockingly good meal to make. Research what you will make. Take photos of the process and remember to get your family to feedback on the delights you served up.
