Engage your reader by including a variety of sentence openers, quality vocabulary and a range of punctuation.</p> |  <p>Research how food was rationed during WWII. Cook a typical meal eaten during this time. Remember to take photos and ask your family for feedback.</p> |
|  <p>During WWII, people were encouraged to grow their own vegetables. Select one vegetable to grow in your garden or in a pot. Share your success with photos.</p> |  <p>During WWII, people had to repair or upcycle items. Is there anything you have given a makeover to or would like to upcycle? Remember to take photos.</p> |
|  <p>We are all unique, like Unique the Unicorn. Write a poem to show your individuality (how unique you are).</p> |  <p>Create a 15 minute workout designed to keep you fit and healthy.</p> |
|  <p>Air raid shelters were important during WWII. Investigate the different types and design and build one using junk modelling / recycling materials.</p> |  <p>Construct a sail boat that both floats and moves quickly across water. It must be durable enough to take the weight of a Lego figure (or something of similar size/shape). Measure the distance of the water tray and time how long it takes to successfully travel from end to end.</p> |
