

Year 4 Welcome Meeting

Reading

- ▶ Daily comprehension lessons take place in school.
- ▶ Class teacher reads to the whole class every day.
- ▶ SSR - Children read to themselves and can complete quizzes.
- ▶ Encourage children to read at home for pleasure and as an enjoyable activity.

Writing

- ▶ Children will learn new writing skills, but consolidate many taught previous skills, ready for the last stage of primary education.
- ▶ Children will write different types of narratives, non-fiction and poetry.
- ▶ Weekly spellings will be taught and applied in written work, and tested with weekly dictation sentences.

Maths

- ▶ Children will consolidate previously taught knowledge and skills and work with larger numbers, refine written methods further and develop vocabulary and skills with measurement and geometry.
- ▶ Children need to know their times-tables up to 12x12 by the summer term.

Creative days, trips and visitors

- ▶ Visits to the local library.
- ▶ Visitors from the local community.
- ▶ Creative days around our topics and spoken language.

Home Learning

- 10 weekly spellings – set every Monday. The children will be tested on some of these words every Friday.
- Weekly maths home learning activity - set every Monday and due in on Friday.
- Reading – 10-15 minutes five times a week. Reading records are handed in and returned every Monday.
- Half-termly home learning bingo.
