Year 3 Home Learning Bingo Autumn 1

Complete one of these activities each week. Keep a record in your Home Learning book by writing, drawing or gluing in a photo. Tick your Bingo grid to show which ones you've completed.
(You should have 2 extra.)

<p>Make a stick person Go on a journey and on your walk find resources to make your stick person.</p>  <p>Take a picture and glue in the photo.</p>	<p>Draw a map of your journey to school</p>  <p>Think about the different things you may pass on your journey (park, shops etc.) and include them on your map.</p>
<p>Design a poster about Wickford</p>  <p>Encourage people to visit our town by drawing a poster. Think about the different things that people could do.</p>	<p>What things come to mind when you think about a journey?</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Transport - Life - Physical - Learning - Items <p>Write or draw down all your ideas.</p>
<p>Reading River</p>  <p>Create a reading river by noting down everything you read in 1 day.</p> <p>Include everything such as labels, menus, road signs, logos etc.</p>	<p>How many different ways can you travel? Jumping, hopping, skipping etc.</p> <p>Use a time to see how many different types of travel you can do in 1 minute.</p> <p>Take photos and glue in the pictures.</p> 
<p>Research and find out about famous journeys, explorers and expeditions from history.</p>   <p>Write some notes about what you find!</p>	<p>Create a worry jar</p> <p>Find a jar, decorate it how you like and label it 'worry jar'. You can write down your worries, pop them in the jar and then discuss them with an adult.</p>

Maths and Spellings

Weekly Maths home learning:

- ▶ On home learning page
- ▶ Complete in home learning book - you do not need to print, we will stick in a copy
- ▶ Bring in every Friday for it to be marked

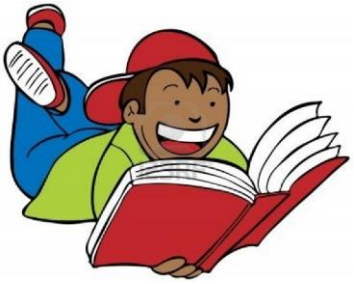
Weekly Spellings:

- ▶ On home learning page
- ▶ Practise throughout week - use a method that works for you!
- ▶ Do not need to be recorded in home learning book
- ▶ Test on Friday in back of writing book





- ▶ Presentation - use capital letters, full stops, write on the lines etc.
- ▶ Times tables - we will be setting times tables
You could use Times Table Rockstars and Hit the Button (website) to practise
- ▶ ActiveLearn, MyOn and Times Table Rockstars log in details are in your child's reading diaries



Reading

- ▶ 5 - 10 minutes a day
- ▶ Monday to Monday - teachers will tick and initial on Mondays
- ▶ We give green dojos to keen readers
- ▶ Front of Reading Record - phonics speed sounds and log in details
- ▶ Fluency is key
- ▶ Talk to children about key words and their meaning, characters, predicting, why, relating to real world knowledge
- ▶ Encourage to reluctant readers, be good role models. You can read comics, magazines, online, read to the child etc.
- ▶ Books sent home will be from the ZPD (assessed as part of the Accelerated Reader programme), appropriate for your child
- ▶ Keep on reading - throughout the year
- ▶ You can also use MyOn and Bug Club (part of Active Learn)
