In brownies and cookies and chocolate cake, it adds extra sweetness to everything you bake.

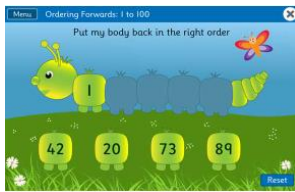
Can you write a short story or a short poem about your favourite food?

Maths Riddle

Can you draw this Maths Riddle and find the answers?

There was nothing on the **first** biscuit.

How many other biscuits had no decoration?
Did any biscuits get all three decorations?



Baking
