



Dream Big

Children will be learning about Significant Individuals including Rosa Parks, Martin Luther King and Neil Armstrong. We will be talking about why they are important and affects they have had on our lives today.

History









English

Children will be writing narratives, non-chronological reports and explanation texts. Joined handwriting will be taught, and children will be learning about how to use apostrophes.

Phonics

Children will continue to learn spellings using the phase 5 graphemes and exploring different strategies to do this. We will be looking at spelling rules and suffixes. They will continue to learn year 2 tricky words.

In art, we will be printing to create natural scenes and using colours to create contrasting tone and depth. We will also be doing some textiles work and learning the running stitch when creating our own animals.

Art

Target Games: Children will develop their understanding of target games, how to score points and play to the rules. Children will develop the skills of throwing, rolling and striking towards targets. Fitness: Children will begin to explore and develop agility, balance, co-ordination, speed and stamina.

They will be given the opportunity to work independently and with others, and they will develop perseverance to work for longer periods of time.

Computing

Children will learn how to create a presentation and that it shares information. They will also learn how to present information and that technology can change.



Readina

In class the children will explore a range of texts including longer chapter books, picture books and non-fiction books to develop their reading skills. They will develop strategies for inference and written comprehension.



PSHE

The children will learn about different jobs that people have and what they do in their job.



Children will be developing their multiplication and division skills. They will consolidate learning about time and data. Money and money calculations will also be a focus.

Music

Children will listen to and appraise reggae music. They will learn to sing a song and play instruments, improvising as they learn more about the song.

Science

Children will learn to identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other. They will also identify and name a variety of plants and animals in their habitats, including micro-habitats
