

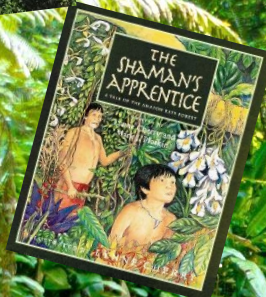
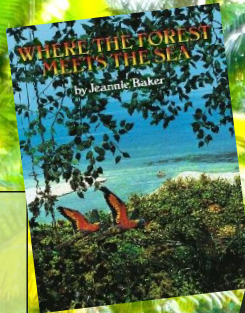
Maths

Children will consolidate methods and strategies to add, subtract, multiply and divide. They will learn more about factors, coordinates, drawing line graphs and finding fractions of amounts.

Reading

Developing a love of reading and a wide range of comprehension strategies by:

- Listening to and discussing class books.
- Reading and discussing fiction, non-fiction and poetry.
- Discussing, preparing and performing poetry.



PSHE - RSE

The children will learn the names of body parts including the difference between males and females, how we and others change, the main stages of a human life cycle and that babies develop in the womb.

PE

Striking & Fielding - children will develop their striking and fielding skills and play a version of rounders called 'zone ball'.

Athletics - children will develop their running, throwing and jumping skills and refine their skills to beat their personal best.

Dance - children will be learning a dance to the song 'Roar' by Katy Perry. Some will perform this at the Dance Festival!

Rainforests at Risk

English

The children will be consolidating their writing skills through the topic of the rainforest. They will develop their understanding of the genres of poetry, narrative and discussion.

Science

The children will construct and interpret food chains, identify producers, prey, consumers and predators, investigate the effect of small and large changes to an environment and consider how humans can reduce the impact of some environmental changes.

RE

The children will learn why the Qur'an is important to Muslims, what it teaches us about God, the ways in which Muslim children learn about the Qur'an and the significance the Qur'an has to Muslims today.

Computing

Children will learn about databases and how to use them.

Art

The children will learn how to use tonal shading and learn the proportions of the human body to create accurate drawings.

Geography

The children will learn what a rainforest is, where they are found, their different layers, deforestation and plants and animals that have adapted to live there.

DT

The children will learn what foods are grown in rainforests and where in the World they are grown. They will taste and evaluate some of these foods and then develop a recipe for banana muffins. Finally, having the opportunity to make them.
