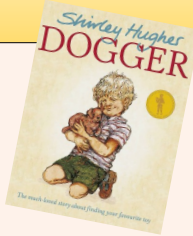
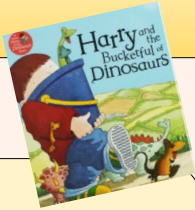




English

Children will practice skills taught in Reception: rehearsing and writing sentences, using capital letters, full stops, applying known GPCs with spelling, finger spaces and letter formation. Children will write descriptions, recounts and stories.



Phonics

- Review previous learnt phase 3/4 GPCs. Looking at words with more than one digraph
- Review phase 2-4 tricky words
- Learn 4 new phase 5 GPCs

Science

Children will learn the difference between the purpose of objects and the materials they are made from, the names and properties of materials and compare materials. Children will also develop their enquiry skills.

Trips, Visitors and Enrichment

Autumn seasonal walk around Wickford.

DT

We are learning to build a cardboard toy garage. We will explore, plan, make and evaluate a stable structure.

Reading

Children will apply their knowledge of GPCs and tricky words. Children will listen to fiction and non-fiction books. Children will listen to and start to learn poems and rhymes every week.

Maths

Children will be counting, estimating and representing numbers beyond 20, addition and subtraction, 2D shapes, Place Value of 1 and 2 digit numbers.

History

Through play and exploration the children will be looking at toys from across the last 100 years. Looking closely at teddy bears and thinking about what has stayed the same and what has changed over time.

The children will also get an opportunity to bring in and share their own toys from home and create our own toy museum.

Computing

Children will be learning about how to stay safe online. They will learn how to stay safe online, different emotions they may feel when online and who to talk to.

RE

Children will be using the five senses to learn about Christianity, Hinduism and Judaism.

Music

By listening to a range of old school hip hop songs children will explore the vocabulary pulse, rhythm, pitch, tempo and dynamics.

We will use a hip hop song to compose, and improvise our own music using glockenspiels.

Well-Being

Children will be learning about the Zones of Regulation and what it feels and looks like to be in each zone, and how to use strategies to regulate.

PE

In our fundamental skills lessons, children will skills of balancing, running, changing direction, jumping, hopping and skipping.

In our ball skills lessons, children will explore and develop their fundamental ball skills such as throwing and catching, rolling and dribbling with both hands and feet.
