

English

Children will look at a variety of story books and poems linked to the topic. They will be building on words they can use to extend their sentences, e.g. but, or, that, when. We will also be introducing expanded noun phrases. Children will also build and develop on their skills in making simple additions, revisions and corrections to their own writing through evaluations.



Computing

What is a Computer?

Children will learn:

- Name some computer peripherals and their functions.
- Recognise that buttons cause effects
- Explain that technology follows instructions.
- Recognise different forms of technology.

Phonics

Children will continue to learn Y2 spellings and develop the skills they need to have to be life-long spellers. They will also read and spell Y2 tricky words.

RE

What does the nativity story teach Christians about Jesus? Children will learn:

- The Nativity narratives are in the books of Luke and Matthew in the Bible.
- How incarnation and salvation relate to one another for Christians.
- Jesus is an important and historical figure to Christians.
- Christians use the nativity story to influence their actions at Christmas, e.g., thankfulness and giving.

Music

Children will listen to artists through history including

Elvis Presley, Frank Sinatra and Hugh Masekela.

Thinking about the style, tempo, dynamics and texture

within the music. They will also learn the rap and play

the glockenspiels along to the song HOHOHO.

Art

Children will learn about primary and secondary colours and creating prints. They will use prints to explore different tones.

PSHE

Children will learn about bullying and how to respond to unkind behaviour.

Maths

In maths, we will be continuing to learn about place value and learn about ordinal numbers.

We will be learning about different strategies for addition and subtraction, including using money in calculations.

We will also be learning about position, direction and length.

Geography

Children will be learning the seven continents and where they are in the world. We will also learn about the equator and the features of hot and cold countries. We will be looking at some of the similarities and differences between the UK and Kenya.

Pl

In PE, children will be learning how to accurately roll, throw and kick a ball, as well as sending a ball using different equipment.

The children will also be doing yoga and learning some of the different yoga positions.

Science

Children will learn that the shape of materials can be changed by squashing, bending, twisting and stretching. We will explore which materials bend or squash most easily and perform simple tests to find the most stretchy materials.

We will also be investigating how materials can be grouped according to their properties.
