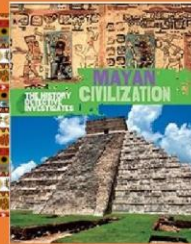
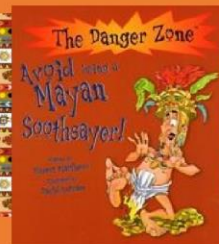


English

Children will learn to:

Multiply a proper fraction by a whole number.

Multiply improper fractions and mixed numbers by a whole number.

Find unit and non-unit fractions of whole numbers exploring parts and wholes.

Comparing fractions using equivalence and decimals.

Science – Animals including Humans

In this unit, children will be able to describe the changes as humans develop to old age including:

- Creating a timeline to indicate stages in the growth and development of humans.
- Researching the gestation periods of other animals and comparing them with humans.

History - Mayans

Children will study the ancient civilisation of the Maya people. They will learn:

- who the Mayans were and know when and where they lived
- how religious beliefs were important to the Mayans (inc. sacrifice)
- why mathematics was important to the Mayans
- how Mayans designed and built their cities.

PSHE –

In this unit the children will learn to:

- Prioritise needs over wants.
- Manage a weekly budget.

- Describe how interest and skills align with future careers.

Art -Sculpting

In this unit child will learn to:

- Research and identify different types of Mayan Masks.
- Design, edit and improve a mask design.
