Kaleb Sharp, 5SY has completed his stage 5 swimming and has moved up to dark blue hat.

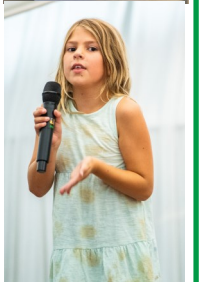
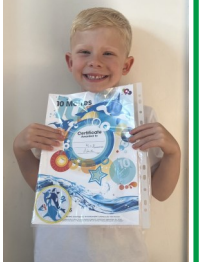
Annabelle Burdiss, 1RJ completed her 2nd nuclear race with who other friends in 1TB. It was super muddy but fun.

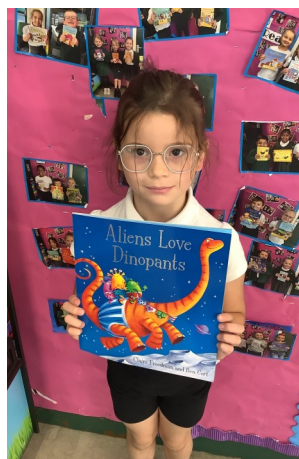

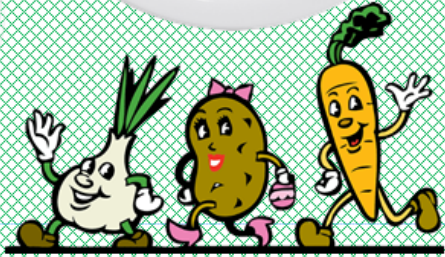
