Superheroes

Children will learn a range of early writing and reading skills including use of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops.



Phonics

This term the children will be continuing to learn phase 5 graphemes along with phase 5 tricky words. We will identify gaps and address these as we move through the phase.

Science

Children will deepen their learning about materials from last half-term, and make more comparisons using greater vocabulary. Children will learn about materials that float, sink, are transparent and are opaque.

Art

We will explore the art work of Andy Warhol. Exploring his use of colour, repeated images and technique of printing. We will create our own pop art, art work all linked to the superheroes topic!

Geography

Children will learn about different maps, how to read them and create simple maps of their classroom, the playground and the local area. Children will suggest ways of improving our playground.

RE

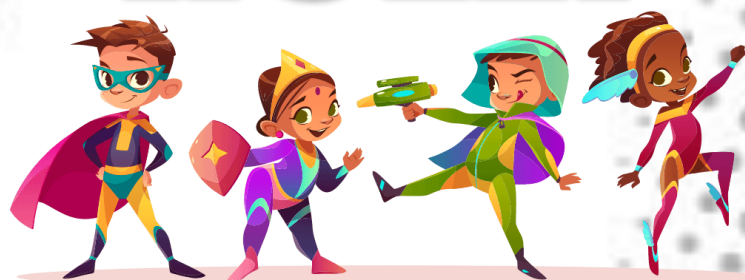
The children will be using their senses to explore religious artefacts.

They will also have the opportunity to learn about various religions including Christianity and Hinduism.

Maths

Children will deepen their understanding of numbers up to 30 by ordering and comparing numbers, their addition and subtraction bonds to numbers up to 10, recognising and understanding the values of coins up to £2, counting on and back y 1, 2 and 3, position and direction and measuring lengths.

Computing

The children will develop their understanding that computers and devices around us use inputs and outputs. They will also be able to talk about what an algorithm is.

PE

Yoga – children will learn about mindfulness and body awareness. They begin to learn poses and techniques that will help them to connect their mind and body.

Sending and receiving - develop their sending and receiving skills including throwing and catching, rolling, kicking, tracking and stopping a ball.
