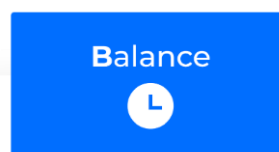

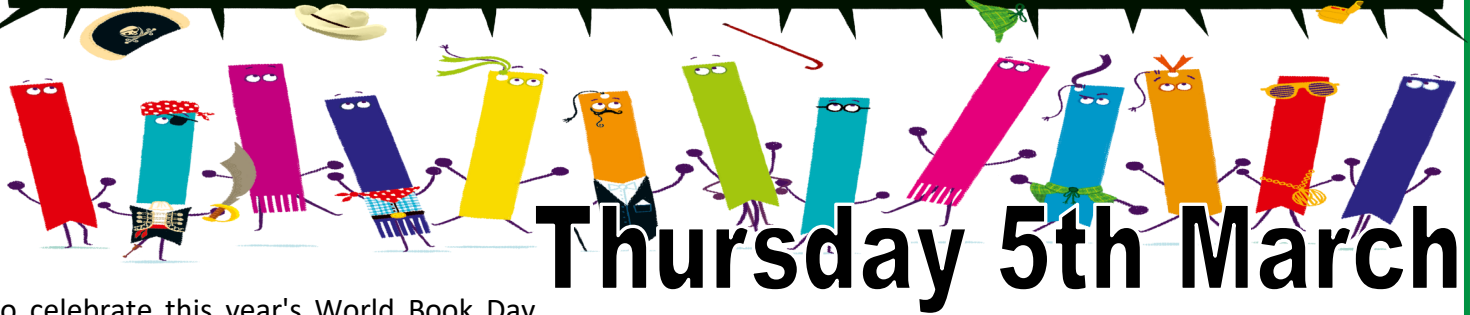

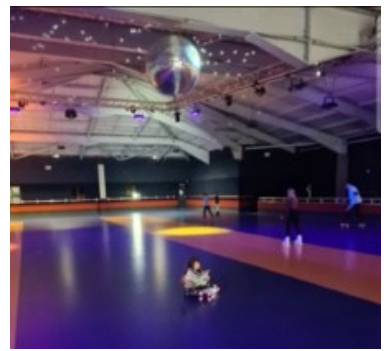
IT'S WORLD BOOK DAY!

Orders close strictly on **1st June**. We cannot accept any late orders.

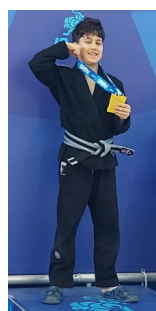

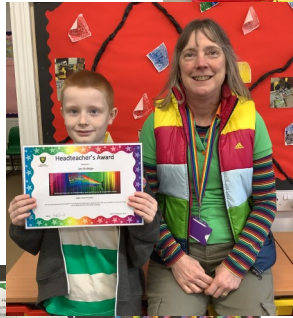

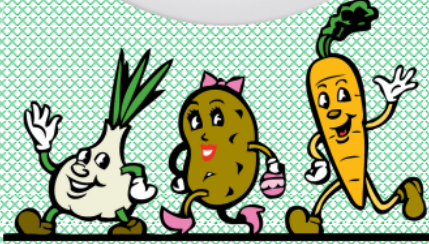
