They thoroughly enjoyed the experience and all passed their Level 1 this week.



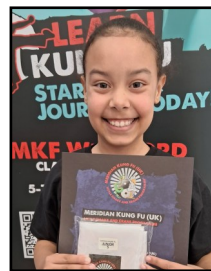
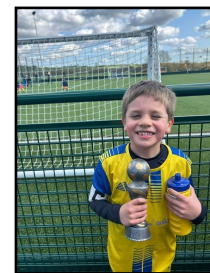

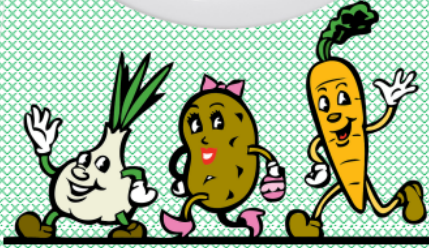
