

Our Planet

Year 1 Summer 1

Phonics

Children will consolidate their phase 5 GPCs and continue to practice reading longer words, sounding out unfamiliar words and chunking them.

English

Children will consolidate their learning this half term by sequencing using time connectives, using question marks and exclamation marks, and applying Phase 5 sounds. They will also continue to develop their use of the conjunction **and** to add words and clauses. Children will begin to learn how to use prefixes and suffixes and will write both narrative and non-fiction texts, including real events.



DT

During a DT day the children will prepare, taste test and make their own smoothies. The children will also make links with science thinking about how and where different plants and vegetables grow.



Maths

Children will deepen their understanding of place value with 2-digit numbers, continue to develop their addition and subtraction skills, and learn to count in 2s, 5s, and 10s. They will improve their understanding of measuring (weight and capacity), learn about money, and continue to apply their maths skills through worded problems.

PE

In net and wall games, children will play against each other, developing their racket and ball skills. They will learn how to hit over a net and keep score. In field, children will run at different speeds and show control and balance when travelling at different speeds.

Geography

Children will be learning about what the weather is like in the UK. They will look at seasonal changes and investigate daily weather patterns.



Science

Children will be exploring the seasons and looking at their differences. The children will collect data on temperature, weather and rainfall weekly. They will start thinking about what time the sun rises and sets and how that affects light.

PSHE

Children will be learning about democracy, laws, rules and the school environment.



Music

Children will listen and appraise to a range of styles of music, learn to sing 'In the Groove' and improvise with instruments.

Computing

Children will learn about to create digital imagery. They will learn how to hold a camera still, how to edit a photo and how to search safely for images online.
