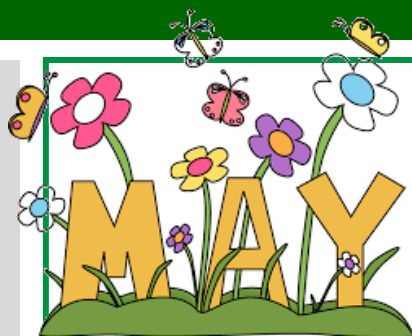

My Future Careers Life from Earth

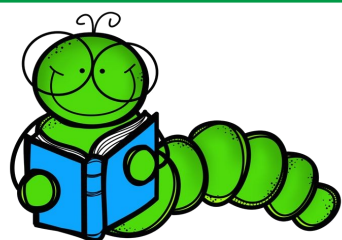


We have been looking at careers that link to 'Life from Earth' and how we can have an impact.

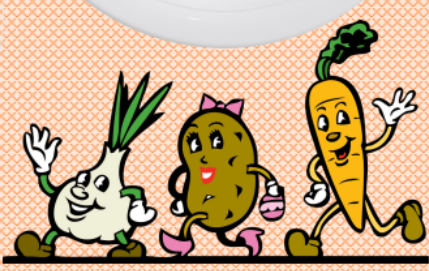
